Coaches and parents are expected in all instances and all situations to set a proper example for the children in our organization. Our goal is to not only try and teach the proper techniques and rules of the games, but to also demonstrate a level of sportsmanship and respect when teaching these children and working with other coaches, referees, and officials.

This Code of Conduct was prepared to give all those involved with Hillcrest Lakers some guidelines as to the lessons we are trying to teach and the examples we are trying to set for the kids.

We recognize that this Code of Conduct cannot outline all the scenarios; so when issues do arise that have not been clearly defined, we ask that you look back to the spirit of this Code of Conduct as a guideline.

*ALTHOUGH WE PROMOTE THE DESIRE TO WIN AND TO HELP THE CHILDREN LEARN WHEN THEY LOSE, THE REAL LESSON IS IN THE SPIRIT OF THE GAME AND THE SPIRIT OF THE TEAM.*

- There is to be no profanity.
- There will be no physical contact, or attempted physical contact, with another person.
- There is to be no arguing with officials, coaches, parents, or children.
- Coaches will control the parents of their team and protect all Hillcrest children.
- Verbal abuse of any child will not be tolerated.
- Parents are spectators only and are not to interfere with the game. If there is a problem, report it to your coach or a club official.
- Coaches may ask the official to explain a call. Once the official's decision is made, there will be no further discussion and the game will continue.
- Follow all the rules. If you were not given rules or do not understand them, speak to your commissioner.
- Obey instructions given to you by a club official.
- You are to instruct a child when they make a mistake, not yell at, or ridicule them.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES COULD RESULT IN SUSPENSION OR EXPULSION FROM THE CLUB.
